**SCORING** – You need to arrive 15 minutes before the sports start and help get everything ready. You need to read the modified rules for the event, these are available from the Sports Co-Coordinator. Once each game is finished you need to give the score card to the winning team. Following your sport if you can help by taking the sporting equipment and lost property back to the crèche

**UMPIRING** – You need to arrive 15 minutes before the sports start and help get everything ready. You need to read the modified rules for the event, these are available from the Sports Co-Coordinator. Following your sport if you can help by taking the sporting equipment and lost property back to the crèche

**CO-ORDINATING** – You are overseeing the sport, and you are required to pick up the equipment from the SportsFest hub at least 30 minutes before your event starts. You may also need to set up fields etc.

**FIRST AID** – First-Aid kits and fluoro vest will be supplied from the crèche, you are required to be at your sport 15 minutes before the sports begin and wearing your vest. **We only do basic first-aid** anything more than this either call an ambulance or less serious injuries allow someone to drive them to hospital

**HOSPITALITY TEAM** – Your role is to walk around with a thermos at the various sports venues and provide the **volunteers** with Tea, Coffee and Milo. Gear will be supplied from the Crèche

**RUNNER** – Your role is to be at the crèche 15min before sport sessions start and help take things out to volunteers if needed, and if things are forgotten to help out, also to help sort out sports equipment that is returned etc...

**SETUP & PACKUP TEAM** – You will be required to be at the Eaton Rec Centre at 1pm on the Saturday Afternoon to help set up for the night service. This will require setting up the stage and the putting out the chairs. We also ask that you stay back after the service and pack up all the gear as well.
